It's Book Sale Time!

Summer's here, so it's time for the Annual Friends
Summer Gently-Used Book Sale! We'll have tables of books and other
items spread out inside and outside at Bayliss Library (weather permitting).
The sale starts at 9 a.m. on Friday, August 1, and runs until 4 p.m.; on Saturday, August 2. the sale runs from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m. The Saturday Special will be \$3.00 per bag of books—paper, plastic, tote bag, or back pack
(excludes Nearly New, Really Recent, and specially-priced items).

We'll have lots of hardcover and paperback books of all genres, plenty of fun puzzles, a variety of interesting magazines, DVDs and a selection of audio books, all at the bargain price of \$.50 each or 3 for \$1.00. The Nearly -New table will be piled with recent best-sellers, at a great price of \$4.00 each or 2 for \$7.00. We'll have a selection of Really-Recent books for \$2.00 each, and a special table of Free Books—the ones we'd rather give away than throw away. There will be some special-priced sale items and a good selection of Michigan history and marine books.

Our Friends-First Early Bird Sale will be held on Thursday, July 31, from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.. If your annual Friends of Bayliss dues are paid up, your Friends-First postcard entry ticket will be mailed to you; you should receive it by Monday, July 28. But it's still not too late to sign up. Dues are only \$15.00 per year and can be paid at the Bayliss Library Circulation Desk. Once paid, you'll be given a postcard ticket for the Friends-First Sale. We've got 2 special offers for the Friends-First Sale: Bring in your Friends of Bayliss tote bag and fill it up for only \$5.00. Or get 1 free hardcover or paperback book. (Offers do not include Nearly New, Really Recent, or specially-priced items.) If you don't have a Friends of Bayliss tote bag, you can buy one at the Bayliss Circulation Desk or at the Friends-First Sale, for only \$10.00. It's our way of saying "Thanks for Being a Friend of Bayliss Library!"

And many, many thanks to Jeanne for her many years of dedication to the Friends of Bayliss organization. Jeanne has been a stalwart book sale worker and the driving force keeping the Bayliss Browse on-going book sale stocked with new materials. We'll miss you, Jeanne! But she says she'll still be around for the book sales.

We have also accepted the resignation of another long time Board member, Louise Armstrong. Louise and her husband have been "Snow Birds" in Florida for many years but are not able to come back "home" for the summers at this time.

With these recent resignations, we are looking for a couple of new board members to join our team. We currently have 12 board members but our By-Laws allow up to 15. Also at the Summer meeting, we made a donation of \$6,800 to Bayliss Library, to pay for half of the cost of removing the landscaping on the library grounds. (An

anonymous donor paid the other half of the cost.) Before the work began, the plants and shrubs to be removed were offered to library patrons, so some of them will thrive in new locations.

We were very happy to hear that Bayliss Library is participating in the "Gather 2 Grow" program this summer. This program is sponsored by Feeding America West Michigan, to provide pre-packaged 'grab & go' lunches to kids age 18 & under and developmentally-delayed adults up to age 26. The lunches are available at Bayliss Library on Wednesday thru Friday, between 11:30 a.m. and 1 p.m., and runs until August 29th. It's a great way to nourish kids' bodies and minds during the summer—and it's free, with no questions asked. Please send any kids you know who could benefit from free lunches! Several other UP libraries are also participating in this great program.
