

Book Sale Results

After a 3-year shut down, we were finally able to hold our Big Summer Book Sale this year. The sale days were July 29 & 30, but the work started with Book Donation Days in June and July, to gather some new stock of books. With help from many volunteers, we hauled the boxes of books, DVDs, puzzles, and magazines from our storage unit, and started sorting everything on Tuesday, July 26th. By Thursday afternoon, everything was in place and ready for the Friends-First Early Bird Sale, which was held from 4:30 to 5:45 p.m. And our Friends members came to shop, bringing in over \$550 at the early sale—a great start to this Summer Book Sale.

Friday, the 29th was a busy sale day, inside and outside of Bayliss Library. Saturday was a slower day but we still moved a lot of books and most of the puzzles. By the close of the sale on Saturday, our Summer Book Sale

had raised over \$1,600.00—all to support Bayliss Library! Many thanks to all of our sale shoppers; it was great to see you back!
